




#### **Overview**

# Who is the CCM?

- 1) CCM members represent the interests of country level stakeholders in the fight against HIV, TB, and malaria.
- 2) CCMs are mechanisms for public-private partnership in the governance of national disease programs.
- 3) On behalf of the country, CCMs request financing from the Global Fund, and provide strategic oversight to ensure effective and strategic implementation of programs.
- 4) As individuals, CCM members are accountable to the sectors they represent and as a group the CCM is accountable to the nation.
