This letter states our co-financing commitments for the Global Fund's 2023-2025 allocation period, which for Lao PDR, shall cover the period 2024-2026.

We make these co-financing commitments because we understand the importance of robust and increasing domestic financing for our national HIV, TB and malaria national responses, and resilient sustainable systems for health (RSSH). The co-financing commitments set forth in this letter also take into account our overall macroeconomic and fiscal situation and are based on our assessment of the level of domestic resource mobilization that we can achieve in a sustainable manner while also considering other health, social and economic priorities for our country.

30 April 2027	Co-financing Monitoring Report on execution of Y3 commitments; Purchase orders relating to programmatic commitments (2026)

These requested disease-specific amounts will be consolidated into the MOH budget for each fiscal year and submitted to the MOF in June. MOF will submit this to the parliament in July. The endorsement and approval will be made in the November of every year and subsequently confirmed to Global Fund in writing.

The report of the actual government expenditure with breakdown per modules, and supporting evidence in the form of expenditure report will be submitted to the Global Fund as part of the annual reports every year.
