# 1. Steps leading to Elections – summary

# **2a. Election Process – workshop 4-5 June 2025**

## **Day 1: 4 June 2025**

### **A. Orientation/Training on:**

- the Global Fund, CCM, roles & responsibilities of CCM Members; CCM in Lao;
- The Oversight role of the CCM; - Community Engagement;

### **B. Election preparation:**

#### **1. Lists of Candidates Validated (confirmed names);**

#### **2. Election Process explained for Day 2:**

- a. Each candidate to make a 3-5 min speech (to present him/her-self);
- b. Candidates organized in 5 sub/groups;
- c. Each KP group member to cast a vote their representative;
- d. Voting to be by secret ballot in boxes;
- e. Each sub-constituency to elect their own representatives

## **2b. Election Process – Wkshp 4-5 June 2025**

### **Day 1: Candidates were Validated**

1. MSM (4 candidates) + TG (2 candidates)
2. FSW (1 candidate + 1 Youth (HIV-specific))
3. PLHIV (8 candidates)
4. Malaria (3 candidates+1 Youth (Malaria-specific))
5. TB (4 candidates)

--5 sets of voting ballots prepared (1/KP group)

## **2c. Election Day Process – workshop 4-5 June 2025**

### **Day 2: 5 June 2025**

#### **VOTING PROCESS:**

**Step 1:** Candidates/voters organized in 5 KP sub-groups (MSM/TG, FSW/Youth, PLHIV, TB, Malaria/Youth);

**Step 2:** Candidates presented themselves to the plenary (5min);

**Step 3:** Official voting ballots distributed to all eligible voting members of 5 sub-groups;

**Step 4:** Each sub-KP group member voted for 2 names

--marked the ballot, folded it, placed it in specific boxes;

--Each member had 2 votes (as agreed by EC and the meeting).

## **2d. Election Day Process – workshop 4-5 June 2025**

### **Day 2: 5 June 2025**

#### **COUNTING VOTES (public/transparent):**

**Step 1:** Election Committee opened ballots, announced each vote and marked it on the FlipChart (per each sub-group);

**Step 2:** The votes were marked on the flipchart;

---candidates were ranked by number of votes;

**Step 3:** In case of a tie (2 names with same number of votes), 2<sup>nd</sup> round of voting was conducted (still in secret ballot);

- This was done in two cases:

- For a member of TB affected group;

- For an alternate of MSM/TG group.

**Final results:** 4 Females/6 Males; 5 Vientiane/5 provinces



## 4. Additional Outputs from the Workshop

- Through 2 Group Work Exercises, participants generated:
  - Day 1: GW 1:
    - A list of Community Engagement Activities currently conducted;
    - Challenges experienced/ proposed way forward;
  - Day 2; GW 2:
    - A draft Community Engagement Plan was generated for CCM;
      - Divided by each of the 5 sub-groups;
      - With estimated quarterly activity plans.
    - Capacity Assessment for KP members conducted (23 pax);
      - Test with 20 questions (10 on CCM/10 on Oversight).

- a. CCM Secretariat to contact new members;
  - establish a WhatsApp Group;
  - CCM Secretariat will share official CCM TORs with members;
